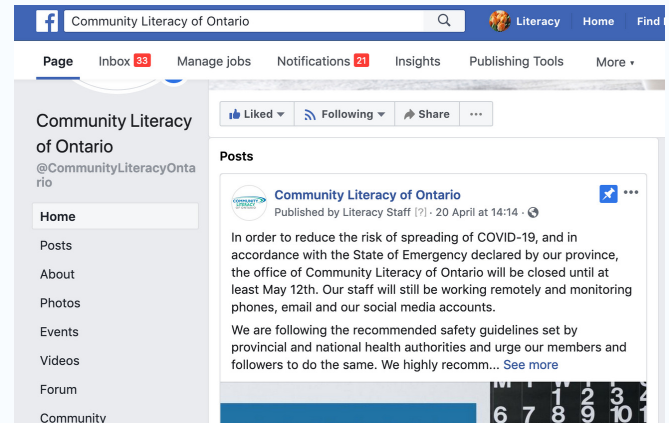
How To: Pin a Post on Your Facebook Page



WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?

A pinned post is the first post visitors will see when they visit your page. You want to communicate your important info with this post.

If you make more posts, the important announcement post is buried in your timeline. Make it easy for people to understand the changes to your services with a pinned post!



HOW TO PIN A POST?

- Click on the three dots at the top right of the post you want to pin.
- Then, click "Pin to top of page"

That's it! Your post has been pinned and will be easily found by everyone who visits your Facebook Page!

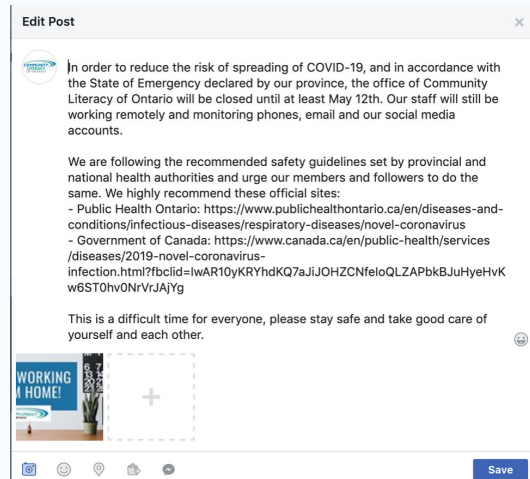


DON'T FORGET!

Remember to update the information in the post if your circumstances change.

To do this, click the three dots and then "Edit post"

TIP: If your location is closed and not offering remote services, update your hours to show that you are closed.

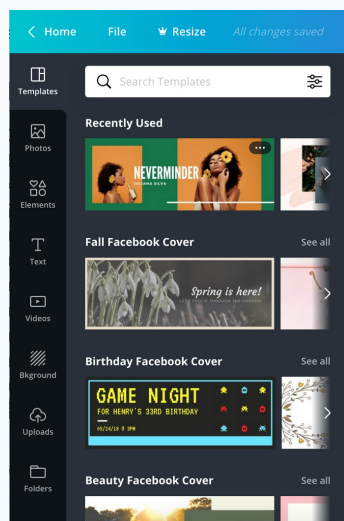
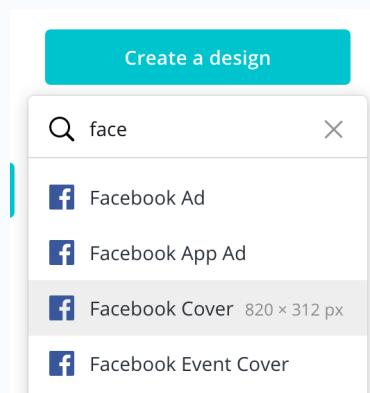
How To: Create a Header Image for Your Facebook Page

USING CANVA.COM

Canva.com is a free online design service.

- Create an account
- Click "Create a design" button
- Search for "Facebook Cover"
- Click "Facebook Cover" to open a new template



CHOOSE A TEMPLATE

Scroll through all the free(!) templates available in the left hand menu.

Remember that you can upload your own logo & images, change colours, fonts, and reorganize the layout.

TIP: For this header, you're aiming to communicate changes due to COVID-19, so choose a template with space for text.

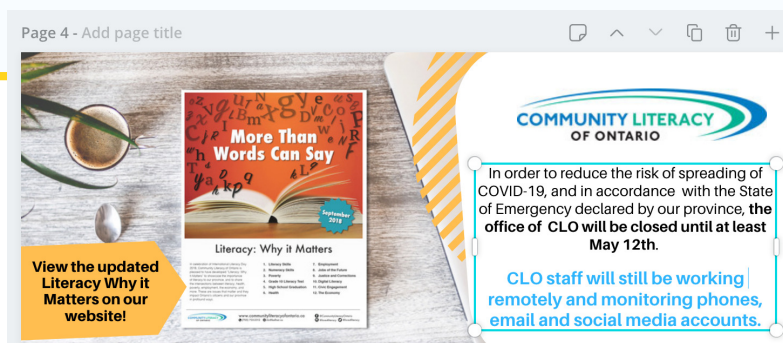

How To: Change Your Header Image on Your Facebook Page

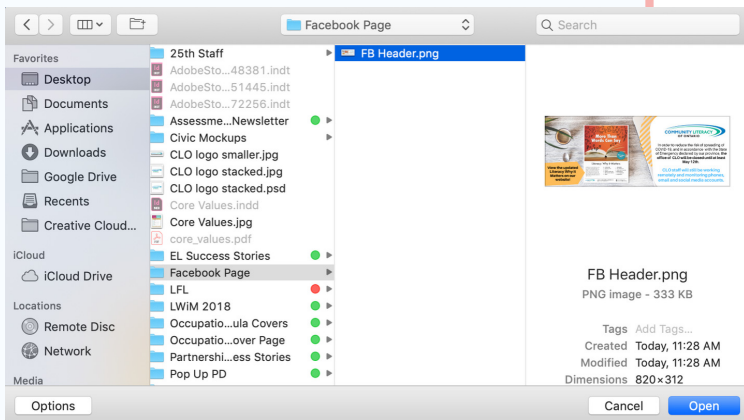
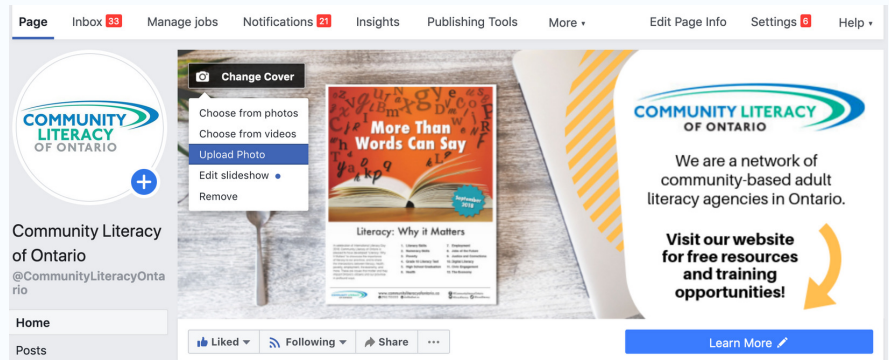

UPLOAD FROM YOUR COMPUTER

Download your new header image from Canva onto your computer.

While logged into your Facebook Page:

- Click "Change Cover"
- Then click "Upload photo"



UPLOAD THE NEW HEADER

Select the image from your computer and click "Open".

TIP: If you're having trouble finding the image on your computer, check your downloads folder.

If you're still not sure where it downloaded to, try downloading it again and this time, select the folder you'd like to to be saved in.

DON'T FORGET!

Now that you've updated your Facebook Page, check the rest of your online presence to make sure you've clearly communicated changes and that the updates are easy for a visitor to find.

Twitter: Pinned tweet, header image

Instagram: Bio, URL in your bio

Website: Homepage, or create a pop-up or announcement bar that leads to a special announcement page.
