Overview

Server Life Overview

Servers and delivery workers have busy lives. They work long hours and often late into the night. It can be hard to keep up with the other side of the job: the paperwork.

The paperwork is one of the biggest challenges of this kind of work. Servers and delivery workers are paid an hourly wage. But a lot of their pay also comes from tips. Tips can be very hard to keep track of. Not knowing how much you made in tips is a problem. It means not being sure:

- what your income is
- how much you make per hour on average
- whether you are making more or less in a given week

Being unsure about your financial situation also means that you won't know how much you owe in taxes. And it makes it very difficult for you to do a budget or save for something special.



The Server Life app helps you to address these challenges. It will help you:

- keep track of your tips
- track your weekly and monthly income
- track your weekly and monthly averages
- load your work schedule and days off
- and more!

The Server Life app is free to use but has a premium upgrade for a cost. This resource will teach you how to download the Server Life app and get to know its main features. But first let's talk about you.

Downloading for iPhone

Server Life App

Now we will get started using the Server Life app for iPhone or Android smartphones. But first we need to download the app onto the phone.

1. Getting Server Life for iPhone

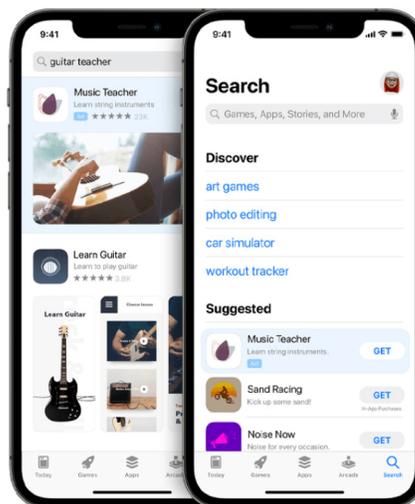
If you have an **iPhone**, start here. (If you have an Android, skip to section 2.)



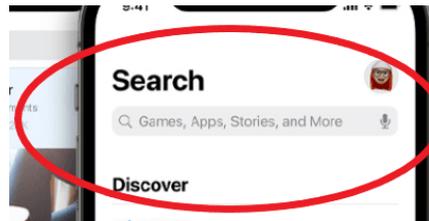
Tap the App Store icon:



The App Store looks like this:



Type in the search bar:
Server Life



Find the correct app. You may have to scroll down a little. Its icon looks like this:

2. Getting Server Life for Android

Tap the Google Play icon:

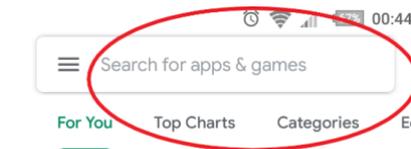


The Google Play store looks like this:

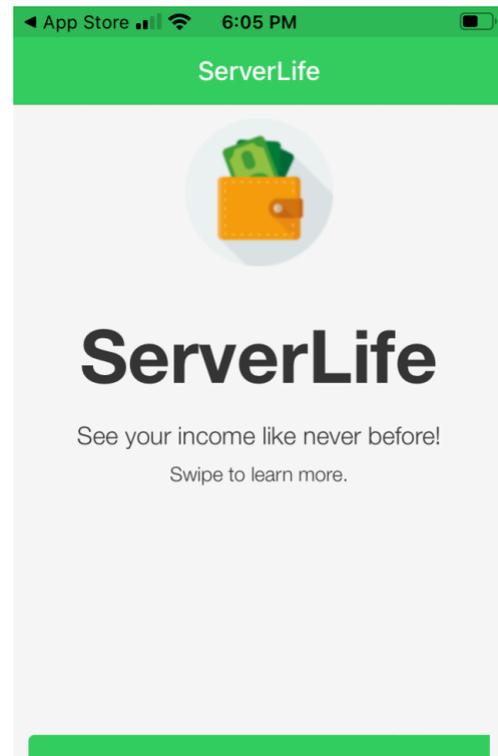

3. Using Server Life

When you have downloaded the app you will be given a short introduction.

This will include help with things like:

- setting up **reminders** so that you don't forget to enter your earnings
- choosing what day you would like your week to **start on** (servers and delivery workers often have their weekends on Monday and Tuesday)

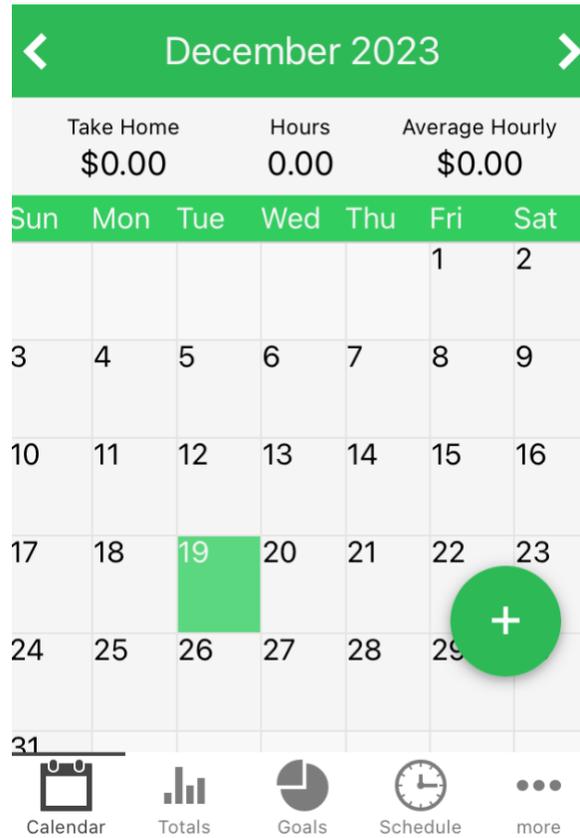

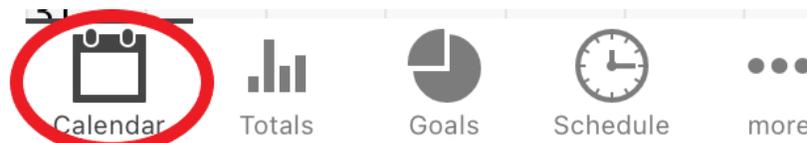
Server Life’s main feature is the **calendar**.
When you begin it will look like this:

As you begin to use it, it will track:

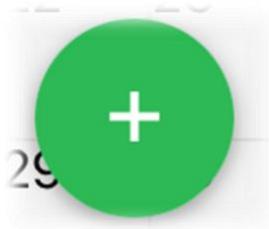
- how many hours you work
- your income
- your average hourly rate



You will always begin on this screen. You can return to it from other screens by tapping the **Calendar** icon at the bottom:



To use the calendar, you will tap the green circle in the bottom right corner:



Tapping the green circle will open four new circles.

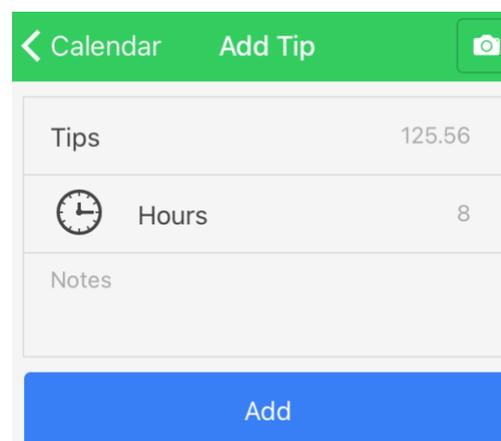
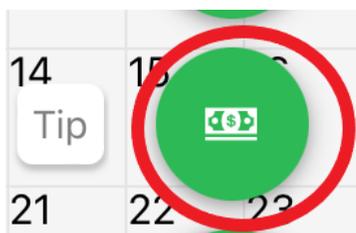
Tap to see what each one is for. Write what each is for beside the circles below:

- The happy face is for tracking your off days.
- The lock is for uploading your paycheque (but it requires a premium subscription).
- The **dollar bill** is for entering your tips.
- The minus symbol closes the circles.



Let's look at the dollar bill first. Tap it and you will arrive at a screen that allows you to enter your tips earned and work hours:

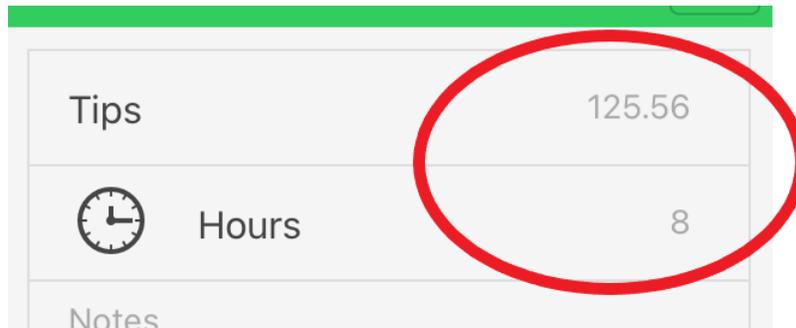




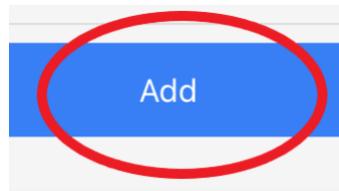
Now you try it.

Enter tips and hours.

1. Enter an amount for **tips** and **hours**. (You can make the amounts up or enter **100** for tips and **6** for hours.)



2. Tap **Add**.



3. Go back to the calendar.

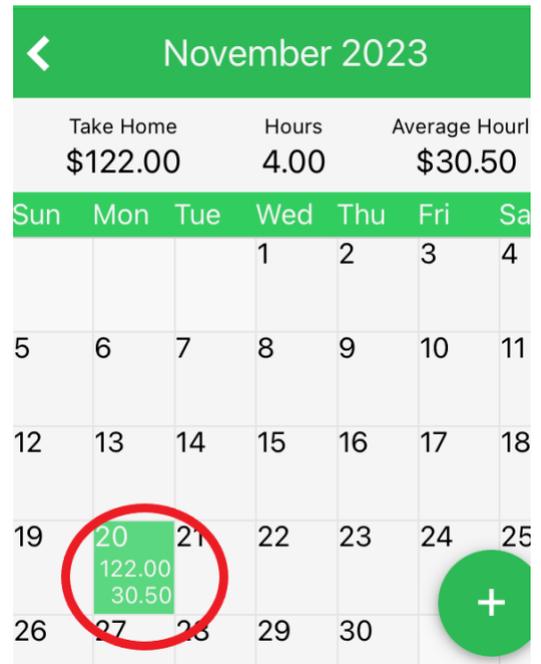
At the top you will see:

your income

hours worked

average hourly wage

On the date of the entry, you will see your income and hourly wage for that day.

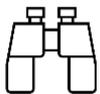


As you enter your tips and hours through the week, your **average hourly wage** will change.

On good tipping days, your hourly wage will be **higher**.

➤ **Remember:** this includes only your tips, not what you earn on your paycheque.

Let's look at an example.

K works as a server at a diner. The first week of October K worked four nights in a row from Wednesday to Saturday. K also worked Sunday brunch. These were K's hours and tips for the week:

	Wednesday	Thursday	Friday	Saturday	Sunday
Tips	\$98*	\$123	\$207	\$221	\$209
Hours	5	6	8	8	7

*Change to Canadian dollars in the settings by tapping **More**:



**New Task!**

Calculate the weekly income and averages.

1. Don't forget to change the app to Canadian dollars in **Settings** (see above).
2. Go to the **Calendar**.
3. Find the first week of October.
4. Enter K's tips and hours for the week.

5. What were K's total earnings for the week?

6. What was K's average hourly wage for the week?

7. What day did K have the highest hourly wage?

8. What day did K have the lowest hourly wage?



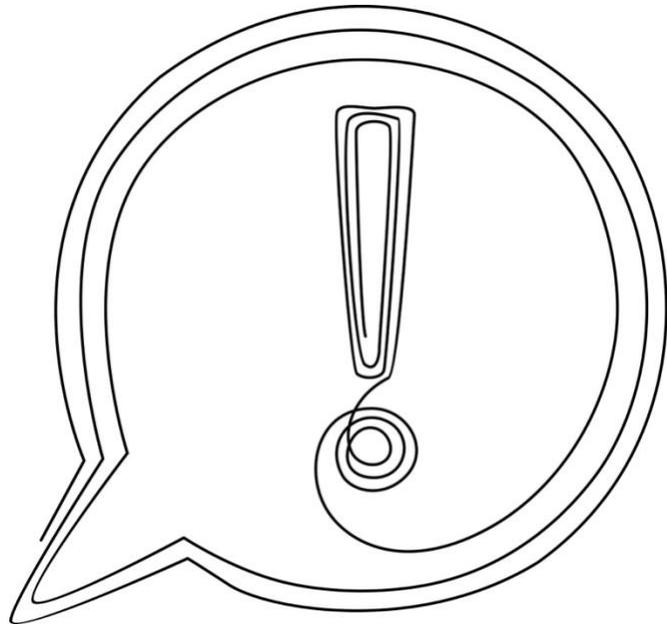
Answers:

K's total earnings for the week: **\$858.00**

K's average hourly wage for the week: **\$25.24**

K had the highest hourly wage on: **Sunday (\$29.86)**

K had the lowest hourly wage on: **Wednesday (\$19.60)**



More Features

Totals

The Totals section can be accessed by tapping the icon below:

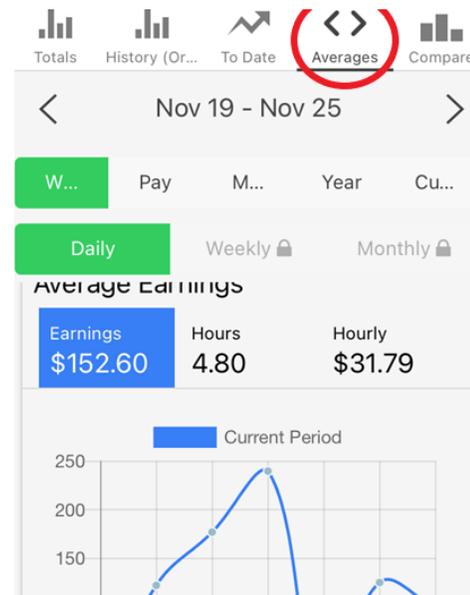


In this section you can find **charts** that show your earnings over time.

Tap the Averages icon on the top right.

You will see daily averages of your:

- earnings
- hours
- hourly wage



Now you try it.

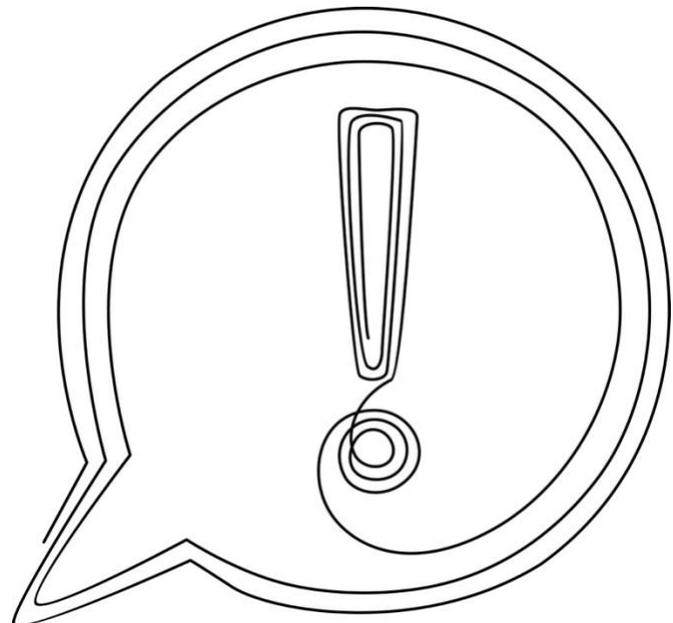
Find averages in the Totals section.

1. Tap on the **Totals** icon at the bottom.
2. Tap on the **Averages** icon at the top.
3. Using the **arrows** on the top scroll to the first week of October.
4. What were K's average daily earnings for that week?
5. What were K's average hours per shift that week?

Answers:

K's average daily earnings for that week: **\$162.25**

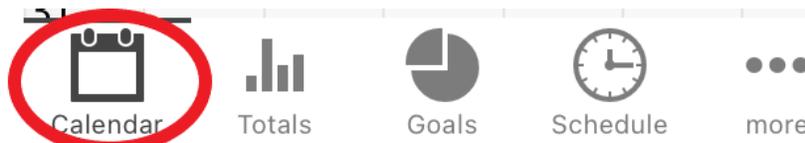
K's average hours per shift that week: **6.75 hours**



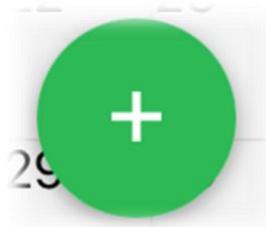
Days Off

Another handy feature of Server Life allows you to mark your days off. Try it out:

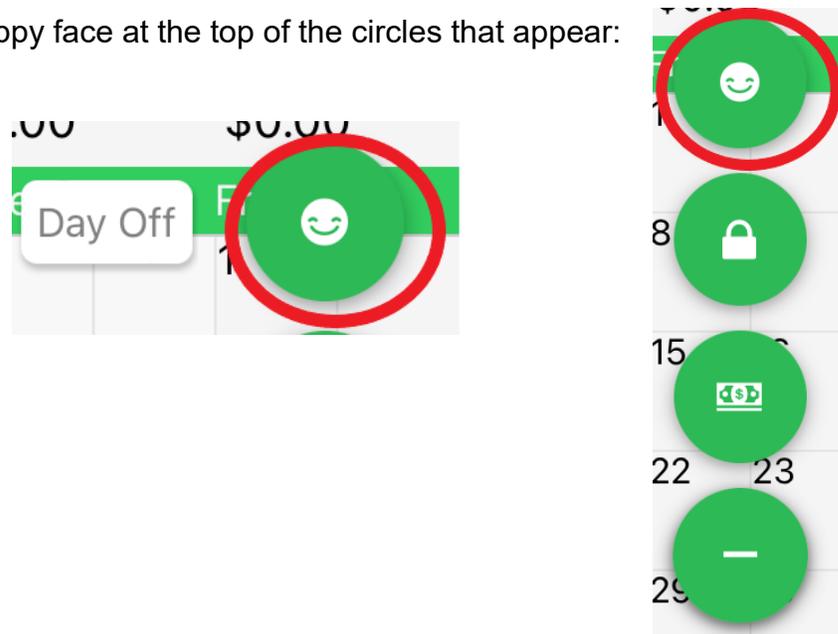
1. Tap the **Calendar** icon to return to the Calendar:



2. Tap the green circle:



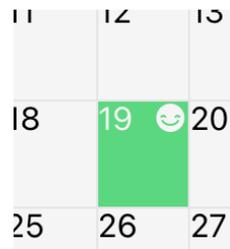
3. Tap the happy face at the top of the circles that appear:



4. Enter the reason you took the day off:

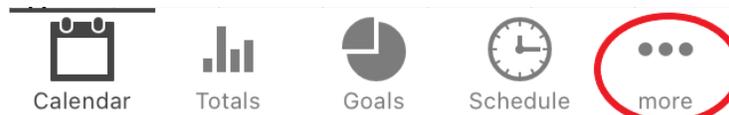

Extra Features

Finally, tap the **More** icon at the bottom:



Here you can access other features like:

- help articles to make using the app even easier
- chat support from the service life support team
- changes to your account like:
 - start day of the week
 - currency the app uses (switch to Canadian dollars)
 - and more!

Skills for Success

The **Skills for Success** (SFS) are the everyday skills Canadians need for work, learning and life. Several SFS are required for you to be successful using the Server Life app:

- **Numeracy.** Numbers skills are essential when working with financial info. This app does a lot of the math for you. But it's always good to double check the numbers.
- **Digital.** The Server Life app requires flexing your basic digital skills. You will need digital skills to download and navigate the app.
- **Problem Solving.** Using apps to make your work life easier is a kind of problem solving. Identify the problem. Then think about it carefully. Then work toward a solution.
- **Creativity and Innovation.** Sometimes applying technology to on the job or apprenticeship problems is a way to show creativity and innovation. Keep learning new tools!
